Infrastructure

Keeping ourselves up with the pace of the modern world there are lots of infrastructural changes. We are proud to inform you that we were having digitally enabled smart rooms with systematic curriculum and this year we have added 11 new interactive smart TV’s in all classes to improve the learning experience by providing infinite number of audio visual aids. Our school has a well-maintained library with more than 2800 books and this year we have added approximately 200 more books. Reading and Writing development programs are also introduced to encourage lifelong reading habits and vocabulary building among students. To ensure the security of our students, more CCTV cameras are installed everywhere in the school campus including senior classes.

Co-curricular activities & Achievements

To promote the competitive spirit and to bring out the talent of the students, they are encouraged to participate in various co-curricular activities which are shared and guided by CBSE.

Science Exhibition - The art and science exhibition was held in the month of August. The students came forward with creative ideas and models on different topics given separately for every class.

Medical camp- An eye checkup camp was organized by our school and free spectacles to around 15 students was also provided. Various health related seminars on Diabetes awareness, organ donation and physical health by the team of eminent doctors of Delhi NCR.

School Assemblies – Our School Assemblies are planned in a way that every student gets ample of opportunities to come forth with self courage and express their abilities of public speaking, reading, thought sharing etc.

Olympiad - More than 100 students will participate in National Olympiad by EHF. Keshav Singh received participation certificate in a quiz competition organized by NSIC (National Space Innovation Challenge).

CBSE Activities - 143 students from our school participated with their parents in International Yoga Day Celebration.

Around 400 student's uploaded selfie on the occasion of Azadi Ka Amrit Mohatsav.

Students of SMS watched the live streaming of Akhil Bhartiya Shiksha Samagam'23 and the launch of India's lunar Mission Chandrayaan 3.

50 students from various classes participated in One Child, One Plant Campaign.

In Veer Gatha Project, a total of 290 students participated in different categories.

Excursion - Our school organizes excursions and field trips every year to help students gain firsthand knowledge and augment their academic learning transacted beyond the confines of a class room, in joyful company of peer & friends. This year students of class I to XII visited Rangmanch farms, where they enjoyed around 80 activities.

We also organised a two day fun trip to JMIT, Radaur for the students of Classes IX to XII where students enjoyed following activities like tree plantation, DJ party, Yoga, Tug of War, Light show at Jyotisar and many other cultural programmes. Students also visited Krishna Museum, Triputi temple, Sidhi Peeth and Kurukshetra University.

Sports- The school is taking initiatives to get the best talent in the sports arena. We have consolidated the sports activities where the students get trained in sports like Dodgeball, Volleyball, Kho-Kho, Chess, Karate, Athletics, Kabaddi, Skipping rope, Shotput etc. Some of our achievements are:

In Shotput, Aditya Pratap of Class IX won Gold Medal, Hunny Parcha of Class X won Bronze Medal in Annual Athletics meet organized by District Athletics Association, Ghaziabad.

Tannu Sharma of Class XI won Gold Medal in 400mtrs. Race and Sumit Sharma of Class XI won Bronze Medal in Long Jump organized by District Athletics Association, Ghaziabad.

Swapnil Thakur of class XII won Gold medal in North Zone Karated Championship 2023.
